

## NOTICE OF ELECTION

TO THE DULY QUALIFIED RESIDENT VOTERS OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY FRESHWATER SUPPLY DISTRICT NO. 6:

Notice is hereby given that a bond election (the "Election") will be held for Montgomery County Freshwater Supply District No. 6 (the "District"), pursuant to an Order of the Board of Directors of the District passed on January 8, 2023 (the "Order"). The Order is on file in the District's office located at 24624 Interstate 45 N., Suite 200, The Woodlands, Texas 77386, where any interested person may refer to it for all purposes. Additionally, a copy of the Order is available on the District's website at [www.lvmwater6.com](http://www.lvmwater6.com).

1. The District has entered into a Joint Election Agreement to be held on May 6, 2023 (the "Contract") with Montgomery County, Texas (the "County") for the purpose of having the County's Election Administrator ("Election Administrator") provide certain joint election services and equipment needed by the District in connection with the Election on May 6, 2023. Said Contract is on file at 24624 Interstate 45 N., Suite 200, The Woodlands, Texas 77386, where any interested person may refer to it for all purposes.
2. The District has adopted the County's early voting and election day polling places for purposes of said Election. Election day voting will be conducted between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on May 6, 2023, at all countywide Election Day Voting Centers. The Election Day Vote Centers are listed on the attached **Exhibit A**. All countywide Election Day Vote Centers are, pursuant to Section 271.003(b), Texas Election Code, declared to be public places for the purpose of this Election, and shall conform to the requirements of Chapter 49 and 54 of the Texas Water Code and the Election Code of the State of Texas, so far as applicable. For additional Election Day Vote Centers, visit [www.elections.mctx.org](http://www.elections.mctx.org). Election Day Vote Centers are subject to change by Montgomery County up until election day.
3. The Montgomery County Elections Administrator shall appoint the Presiding Judge and any required Alternate Presiding Judges or Clerks.
4. Early voting by personal appearance shall be conducted on April 24, 2023, and conclude on May 2, 2023, at the locations and times specified on the Early Voting Schedule, attached hereto as **Exhibit B**, which locations, pursuant to Section 271.003(b), Texas Election Code, are declared to be public places for the purposes of this election.
5. Applications for voting by mail for all residents of the District shall be addressed to: Suzie Harvey, Elections Administrator, P.O. Box 2646, Conroe, TX 77305-2646, Email: [election.ballot@mctx.org](mailto:election.ballot@mctx.org), Fax: 936-788-8340 and must be received (not postmarked) by April 25, 2023. If application to vote by mail is made by personal delivery, the application must be delivered by close of business on April 25, 2023, to Suzie Harvey.
6. The election will be conducted in compliance with the provisions of the federal Help America Vote Act ("HAVA") and the Texas Election Code, and each polling place will have at least one (1) voting system accessible to individuals with disabilities.

7. Voting in said election shall be on paper ballots and/or electronic ballots. Ballots, voting instructions, and the propositions will also be available in English and Spanish languages for persons requesting same.
8. The following proposition(s) shall be submitted to the duly qualified resident electors at said election:

SHALL THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY FRESHWATER SUPPLY DISTRICT NO. 6 BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE BONDS OF SAID DISTRICT IN ONE OR MORE ISSUES OR SERIES IN THE MAXIMUM AGGREGATE ORIGINAL PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$5,000,000 DOLLARS, MATURING SERIALLY OR OTHERWISE OVER A PERIOD OR PERIODS NOT TO EXCEED FORTY (40) YEARS FROM THEIR DATE OR DATES, AND TO BE ISSUED AND SOLD AND AT ANY PRICE OR PRICES AND TO BEAR INTEREST AT ANY RATE OR RATES AS SHALL BE DETERMINED WITHIN THE DISCRETION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE DISTRICT AND AS AUTHORIZED BY THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF TEXAS AT THE TIME OF SUCH ISSUANCE, FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE DISTRICT, FOR THE PURPOSES OF PURCHASING, CONSTRUCTING, ACQUIRING, OWNING, OPERATING, MAINTAINING, REPAIRING, IMPROVING AND EXTENDING A WATER AND SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM, A SURFACE WATER SYSTEM, STORM SEWER FACILITIES, AND SEWAGE DISPOSAL FACILITIES FOR THE DISTRICT, AND A DRAINAGE SYSTEM FOR THE DRAINAGE OF LANDS WITHIN THE DISTRICT, AND FOR PAYMENT OF FEES OR CHARGES TO ANY REGIONAL WATER AUTHORITY OR SIMILAR ENTITY FOR CHARGES OR CONTRIBUTIONS LAWFULLY LEVIED ON THE DISTRICT, AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON SUCH BONDS BY THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF A SUFFICIENT AD VALOREM TAX UPON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE DISTRICT, ALL AS AUTHORIZED BY THE CONSTITUTION AND LAWS OF THE STATE OF TEXAS?

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 49.101 of the Texas Water Code, as amended, the Texas Election Code (the “Election Code”), and other related statutes, the Board of Directors (the “Board”) of Montgomery County Freshwater Supply District No. 6 (the “District”) of Montgomery County, Texas (the “County”) is authorized to call an election in order to submit to the voters of the District the necessary proposition(s) regarding the issuance of general obligation bonds for water, sewer and drainage facilities and related purposes, and for refunding any outstanding general obligations bonds of the District as may be applicable from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Board deems it advisable to call a bond election (the “Election”) for the proposition(s) hereinafter stated; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Order is being adopted was open to the public, and public notice of the time, place and purpose of the meeting was given, all as required by Chapter 551, Government Code, as amended;

WHEREAS, as required by Section 49.106, Texas Water Code, there has been filed in the office of the District, open to inspection by the public, an engineer’s report, and any supplemental letters or amendments, covering the land, improvements, facilities, plants, equipment, and appliances to be purchased or constructed and their estimated cost, together with maps, plats, profiles and data fully showing and explaining the report (the “Engineering Report”), and the Engineering Report has been carefully considered by the Board and has been approved by the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to call an election for the purpose of submitting propositions on the issuance of bonds of the District for the provision of a waterworks system, sanitary sewer system, and a drainage and storm sewer system in the maximum aggregate principal amount of \$5,000,000 and the levy of taxes in payment of such bonds; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to call an election for the purpose of submitting propositions on the issuance of refunding any bonds or refunding bonds in the maximum aggregate principal amount of \$5,000,000 and the levy of taxes in payment of such bonds; and

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to proceed with the ordering of said election. Now, therefore,

The Engineering Report and estimates of costs described above are hereby approved. The election shall be held as a joint election pursuant to Chapter 271 of the Election Code and a joint election agreement to be entered into between the District and other political subdivisions located in the County which are holding an election on May 6, 2023. The Election is to be conducted and administered by the County. Voting for the Election during Early Voting and on Election Day shall occur on the dates and during the hours and at the designated polling place(s) as set forth in Exhibit “A” and Exhibit “B”, respectively, attached hereto and made a part hereof for all intents and purposes. Exhibit “B” shall be modified to include additional or different Election Day polling places as may be deemed appropriate by the County Judge and the County Clerk. Section 2: Unless otherwise directed by the District, the Presiding Judge shall appoint not less than two nor more than five resident qualified electors of the County to act as clerks to properly conduct the election. However, if the Presiding Judge appointed actually serves, the Alternate Presiding Judge shall serve as one of the clerks. The appointment of such clerks must include a person fluent in the Spanish language to serve as a clerk to render oral aid in the Spanish language to any voter desiring such aid at the polls on the Election Day. In the absence of the Presiding Judge, the Alternate Presiding Judge shall perform the duties of the Presiding Judge.

Section 3: Early voting shall be administered by the County. Early voting by personal appearance shall begin on April 24, 2023, and conclude on May 2, 2023, and will be conducted at the Early Voting locations at the times specified in Exhibit "A" attached hereto. The Early Voting polling places shall remain open during such hours for Early Voting by personal appearance for any registered voter of the District at such polling place(s). Suzie Harvey, the Montgomery County Elections Administrator, is hereby appointed the Early Voting Clerk. The Early Voting Clerk's mailing address to which applications for ballots by mail may be sent, for voters residing in the District, is as follows: Suzie Harvey, Elections Administrator, P.O. Box 2646, Conroe, TX 77305-2646, Email: [election.ballot@mctx.org](mailto:election.ballot@mctx.org), Fax: 936-788-8340. Exhibit "A" shall be modified to include additional or different early voting polling places as may be deemed appropriate by the County Judge and the County Clerk.

Section 4: The appointment of the Presiding Election Judges, Alternate Judges, Early Voting Clerks, the Presiding Judge of the early ballot board and other election officials for the Election shall be made by the Elections Administrator, in accordance with the Election Code. The Elections Administrator may employ other personnel necessary for the proper administration of the Election, including such part-time help as is necessary to prepare for the Election, to ensure the timely delivery of supplies during Early Voting and on Election Day, and for the efficient tabulation of ballots at the central counting station. The Presiding Election Judge shall appoint not less than two nor more than eighteen resident qualified electors to serve as members of the Early Voting Ballot Boards.

Section 5: Applications for voting by mail for all residents of the District shall be mailed to: Suzie Harvey, Elections Administrator, 9159 Airport Road, Conroe, Texas 77303 and must be received (not postmarked) by April 25, 2023. If application to vote by mail is made by personal delivery, the application must be delivered by close of business on April 25, 2023, to Suzie Harvey.

Section 6: All qualified electors of and residing in the District shall be entitled to vote at the Election.

Section 7: A substantial copy of this Order shall serve as a proper Notice of Election. This notice, including a Spanish translation thereof, shall be given by publishing at least once, not earlier than the 30<sup>th</sup> day or later than the 10<sup>th</sup> day before Election Day in a newspaper in the territory that is covered by the Election and is in the jurisdiction of the authority responsible for giving the notice; and by posting, not later than the 21<sup>st</sup> day before Election Day, a copy of the notice at a public place in each Election precinct that is in the jurisdiction of the authority responsible for giving the notice. Also, this notice shall be posted on the bulletin board used for posting notices of the meetings of



the governmental body of the District. Additionally, in accordance with Section 4.003(f) of the Election Code, this Order and notice shall be posted at three (3) public places within the District and the County and on the District's internet website, if any, not less than twenty-one (21) days prior to Election Day; and shall be posted on Election Day and during Early Voting by personal appearance, in a prominent location at each polling place.

Section 8: The official ballots for the Election shall be prepared in accordance with the Election Code so as to permit the electors to vote "FOR" or "AGAINST" the aforesaid PROPOSITION(s) with the ballots to contain such provisions, markings and language as required by law, and with such PROPOSITION(s) to be expressed substantially as follows:

Section 9: In all respects, the Election shall be conducted in accordance with the Election Code. Pursuant to the federal Help America Vote Act ("HAVA") and the Election Code, at each polling place there shall be at least one voting system that is equipped for disabled individuals, and each such voting system shall be a system that has been certified by the Texas Secretary of State as compliant with HAVA and the Election Code. The District hereby finds that the voting system to be used by the Elections Administrator in administering the Election is such a system, and orders that such voting equipment or other equipment certified by the Texas Secretary of State shall be used by the County in the Election.

Section 10: The following information is provided in accordance with the provisions of Section 3.009(b) of the Election Code:

- (a) The proposition language that will appear on the ballot is set forth in Section 8 hereof.
- (b) The purpose for which the bonds are authorized is set forth in Section 1 hereof.
- (c) The principal amount of the debt obligations to be authorized is \$5,000,000.
- (d) If the bonds are approved by the voters, the District will be authorized to levy annual ad valorem taxes, on all taxable property in the District, sufficient, without limit as to rate or amount, to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds and the cost of any credit agreements executed in connection with the bonds. The District estimates that, if the propositions contained herein were approved and the bonds proposed herein were authorized and issued, the District's ad valorem debt service tax rate is projected to be a maximum of approximately \$0.4660 per \$100 of assessed valuation. The estimated tax rate is based on current assumptions and projections of interest rates, property development, assessed valuations and tax collection rates. To the extent that such assumptions and projects are not realized, the actual tax rate assessed by the District may vary substantially from the estimated tax rate. The estimated tax rate provided by this Section shall not be considered part of the bond propositions to be submitted to the voters pursuant to this Order and shall not be considered as a limitation on the District's authority to levy, assess and collect a tax rate as to rate or amount pursuant to Texas Constitution Article XVI, Section 59.

- (e) Based upon the market conditions at the date of adoption of this Order, the maximum interest rate for any series of the bonds is estimated to be 4.28%. Such estimated maximum rate is provided as a matter of information but is not a limitation on the interest rate at which the bonds, or any series thereof, may be sold.
- (f) If the bonds are approved, they may be issued in one or more series, to mature serially, over a period not to exceed 40 years from the date of issuance of each series of bonds.
- (g) The aggregate amount of the outstanding principal of the political subdivision's debt obligations as of the date the election is ordered is \$0.00.
- (h) The aggregate amount of the outstanding interest on debt obligations of the political subdivision as of the date the election is ordered, which may be based on the political subdivision's expectations relative to variable rate debt obligations, is \$0.00.
- (i) The ad valorem debt service tax rate for the District at the time the election is ordered, expressed as an amount per \$100 valuation of taxable property, is \$0.00 per \$100 of taxable assessed valuation.

Section 11: The provisions of this Order are severable; and in case any one or more of the provisions of this Order or the application thereof to any person or circumstance should be held to be invalid, unconstitutional, or ineffective as to any person or circumstance, the remainder of this Order nevertheless shall be valid, and the application of any such invalid provision to persons or circumstances other than those as to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

Section 12: The Board of Directors may cancel the election if allowed in accordance with the Texas Election Code.

Section 13: The Montgomery County Elections Administrator shall serve as the custodian of voted ballots and all other election records. The Montgomery County Elections Administrator shall conduct an unofficial tabulation of results after the closing of the polls on May 6, 2023. The official canvass and tabulation of results of the Election shall be conducted in accordance with the Election Code.

Section 14: The President or Vice President and Secretary or Assistant Secretary of the Board of Directors are hereby authorized and directed to take any action necessary to carry out the provisions of this order.

Section 15: In the event that the election results favorably for the propositions submitted, the Board shall thereafter be authorized to issue \$5,000,000 in bonds and \$5,000,000 in refunding

bonds of the District for the provision of waterworks, sanitary sewer, and drainage and storm sewer facilities for the District, payable from taxes, on the terms and conditions described the Propositions voted in the election.
